5. What idea or new guidance has God placed in your mind these days? Will you obey?

Luke 22:26-27 The kings of the Gentiles lord it over them, and those who exercise authority over them call themselves "benefactors." You are not to be like that. Instead the greatest among you should be like the youngest. And the one who rules—the one who has the most power and authority—should be like the one who serves. For who is regarded as greater? The one who sits at the table, or the one who serves? Is it not the one at the table? That's the way things work in our world. But I am among you as One who serves.
