### Half Days and Full Days

There are two half days and a Pro-D day in this September. The half days are on the 22nd and 23rd, and we will be picking your child(ren) up when class is dismissed. We currently do not know the time that school will be out, but we do ask that you pack your child(ren) lunch as we are anticipating eating lunch at our center.

Friday the 24th is a Pro-D day, and on this day we will be offering full-day care. Our facility will be open from 7:30am until 6:00pm and ask that on this day you send your child(ren) with a morning snack and a lunch, we will be providing an afternoon snack.

If your child(ren) is/are registered for these days you will be billed the regular \$17.00 to continue to hold your spot. If you do not wish to send your child(ren) on one or more of these days the surplus will not be added to your bill. If you do wish to have your child(ren) attended one or more of these days, please follow the instructions and fill out the information located along with your bill.

## LEADERSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

## Electronic Devices

Last year we saw a lot more children carrying around DSI's, Itouch's and cellphones. These devices are allowed at SunRidge but there is a time and a place when these are allowed to be used. We provide children with a "Games Day" every second day which allows them to play on our Game Cube or Playstation and to play the games on their electronic devices. Children will be asked to keep these devices in their backpack during their time at SunRidge.
