

DISAPPOINTMENT: John the Baptist – Are You the One? Small Group Questions

- 1. Read Matthew 11:1-6
- 2. When Jesus had finished giving instructions to His disciples, what did He himself do? What do we learn about modeling from this?
 - Why do you think John asked this question of Jesus since he had already stated who Jesus was in John 1:29? Was he having doubt? A change of heart?
- 3. What can we learn from Jesus' answer? Why does He not answer directly with a "yes" or a "no?" What do you think John would think when he heard Jesus' reply?
- 4. What kind of reasons does Jesus think should persuade people to believe in Him?
- 5. Have you ever seen someone demonstrate great faith in God despite difficult circumstances? If so, how did that person's faith influence your own?
- 6. When have you faced a difficult event or season in life that caused you to feel you'd never be happy again or that no good could come from what you were experiencing? What happened?
- **7.** God loves you regardless of whether it feels like he loves you. How would your life be different if you lived as though you fully believed that truth?
