



Church Family Small Group Questions

1. Psalm 68:6 begins with "God sets the lonely in families." What does that look like — how have you personally experienced this.
2. What happens when the church (the people) forget that the church is a family? What happens?
3. Out of the Scriptures Mike lifted, what do these verses say about the kind of family God wants us to be? As you go through each one, also reflect on how these things reveal the heart of God.
Matt18:20 For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them.
Heb10:24 And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds,²⁵ not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.
Prov27:17 As iron sharpens iron, so one person sharpens another.
Acts2:42 They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.
John13:34 A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another.
4. As you have been talking about this, in what ways can your small group grow to be more "family like"?
