1. What is one Terrible Injustice — one horrible thing — that makes you feel wrath?
2. Do you think you carry an appropriate amount of “wrath” for the evil present in the world? Explain.
3. How would you attempt to explain to someone the extreme levels of both love and wrath that God carries with Him?
4. Why is it appropriate for God to avenge and not us? Use these passages to inform your discussion:

Romans 12:19

Isaiah 55:7-9

Isaiah 35:4

Revelation 16:9 and 11

5. Discuss this J.I. Packer quote: “nobody stands under the wrath of God, save those who have chosen to do so”
6. On Sunday Mike said, "Christians will go through the judgement...but we can face this judgement without fear...Rev 20:12 And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Another book was opened, which is the book of life...."
