10. How can we grow in depending on God rather than on ourselves?
11. What door does Jesus describe in verse 20? Is He referring to salvation?
12. What does He mean that He will eat with them?
13. What did this church specifically need to overcome?
14. How does this relate to us in this day and age?
15. What does it mean to sit with Jesus on His throne?
