What time is it? Part 2. Going Deeper Questions, (04/14/24)

Biblical Text: Ecclesiastes 3:9-15

Context: As we continue in our mini-series 'What time is it?', we will examine the next seven verses in Ecclesiastes Chapter 3. Here we sense a different tone from the author. More reflective, gentle, and directional in nature.

He turns out not to be a complete pessimist. He sees the value in doing good work and underscores the joy of fruitful labour that is done in alignment with God's purposes.

He underscores God's imprint of eternity on the human heart and helps us understand our searching and endless craving for more. We want the whole picture. And that is only discovered by the one who surrenders, submits, and falls in adoring, fearful worship of the Most High God.

Going Deeper Questions
